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## WHAT OUR PARENTS, STUDENTS AND STAFF THINK ABOUT OUR CAMPUS

In October 2018, a survey was conducted by YouthTruth Survey. 489 students, staff members and parents responded. The data below highlights our accomplishments, showcases how we are viewed, and areas where we can grow.



### ROSS ELEMENTARY CELEBRATIONS

- 94% of students agree that their teachers want them to work their hardest.
- 92% of staff members believe that their campus communicates a clear direction for the future and 94% are proud of their school.
- 98% of employees state that staff and students care about each other.

### WHERE WE CAN GROW

Does homework help you learn?

- 15% of students responded, “hardly ever.”
- 30% responded, “sometimes homework helps me learn.”
- 55% of students feel, “homework often helps me learn.”
- 67% of parents feel informed about important decisions regarding school.
- 77% of staff report that they have the necessary resources to do their jobs well.

## OUR FOCUS

As a new Title 1 campus, we will focus on parent and family engagement by planning activities based on on-going survey results that will focus on wants and needs.

Implement Professional Learning (PL) focusing on how to check for student understanding and how students can ask for help (i.e., exit ticket).
